PETITION FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

COMES NOW the Petitioner, [Redacted] and for his cause of action against the Respondent, [Redacted] alleges and states as follows:

1. Petitioner is now, and has been for more than six (6) months next preceding the filing of this Petition herein, an actual resident in good faith of the State of Oklahoma, and a resident of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma for more than thirty (30) days at the time this Petition is filed herein.

2. The Petitioner and Respondent were legally married on or about November 17, 2007, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and have remained husband and wife since that time. The parties separated on or about October 26, 2014.

3. Petitioner is entitled to Decree of Dissolution from Respondent. As grounds for the dissolution, Petitioner alleges incompatibility.

4. One child has been born of the marriage, now a minor, namely: [Redacted] born on March 11, [Redacted]; no other children have been born or adopted during the course of the marriage; and Petitioner is not now pregnant.

5. It is in the best interest of the child for joint custody to be granted to the parties.

Both parties are fit and proper persons to have custody of the minor child.

6. Child support, medical expenses and health insurance should be paid according to the Oklahoma Child Support Guidelines. This request for child support is in compliance with the Uniform Interstate Family Support Act (UIFSA), 43 O.S. § 601-100 et seq.

7. This Court has jurisdiction to determine custody of the above-named minor child pursuant to 43 O.S. § 551-101, et. seq., in that this state is the "home state" of the minor child. In accordance with the Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction and Enforcement Act, Petitioner provides the following:

- A. That he is the Petitioner in the above-entitled action.
- B. The Petitioner and Respondent have one child as a result of their marriage. The child's initials and month and year of birth are set forth above.
- C. The above-mentioned child presently resides with Respondent at a home in Tulsa County at [REDACTED]. The child lived at this address since birth with both parties until October 26, 2014. From October 26, 2014, to present she has lived part of the time with Respondent at [REDACTED] and part of the time with Petitioner at [REDACTED].
- D. The child is currently [REDACTED] years old. She was born in Tulsa, Oklahoma in Tulsa County.
- E. Petitioner has not participated as a party, witness or in any other capacity in other litigation in this or any other state concerning custody, including visitation, of the child subject to this proceeding.
- F. Petitioner has no information concerning a custody proceeding pending in a Court of this or some other state concerning the custody of the child subject to these proceedings.
- G. Petitioner does not know of any other person who is not a party to these proceedings who has physical custody of or who claims to have custody or visitation rights with the child who is subject to these proceedings.

H. Petitioner acknowledges that he has a continuing duty to inform the Court of any custody or visitation proceeding in this or any other state of which he later gains knowledge and/or information concerning the child subject of these proceedings.

I. That 25 U.S.C.A. Section 1911, et seq. and 10 O.S. Section 40, et. seq., the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1979 and Oklahoma Indian Child Welfare Act, respectively, do not apply to these proceedings.

8. During the marriage of the parties, they have acquired certain property and indebtedness that should be equitably and fairly divided by the Court.

9. The Court should determine in all of the circumstances of the parties and of the case, what is fair, just and equitable with regard to the payment of attorney's fees and costs, and make such orders as are appropriate considering all of the same.

10. Petitioner does not believe the State of Oklahoma Department of Human Services claims an interest in this case.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, Petitioner prays for a full, final and complete dissolution of the marriage with Respondent; for an equitable division of the debt and property of the parties; for orders concerning the custody and maintenance of the minor child; for the issuance of temporary orders as hereinabove indicated; for attorney fees, if appropriate; and for such other and further relief to which Petitioner may be entitled.

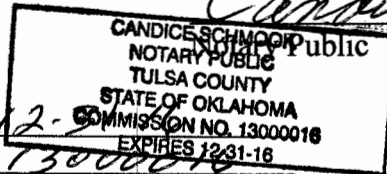


