CONSENT DECREE OF SEPARATE MAINTENANCE

On this 2 day of ^{July} ~~June~~, 2015, this matter comes on before this Court.

The Petitioner [REDACTED] and his counsel of record, James R. Gotwals of JAMES R. GOTWALS AND ASSOCIATES, INC., appear in person. The Respondent [REDACTED] and her counsel Stephan S. Mathis of ASTON MATHIS JACOBSON CAMPBELL TIGER PLLC appear not, having evidenced their approval and agreement to the entry of this Decree by their signature hereon.

The Court, having reviewed the file herein, having listened to the statements of counsel, having listened to the testimony of one (1) witness being first duly sworn upon his oath, having heard the stipulations of the parties and based upon the approval of the parties and by counsel for the Petitioner, hereby enters the following findings and orders:

1. That it has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of this action, and that both parties were actual residents in good faith of the State of Oklahoma for the six (6) months immediately preceding the filing of the Petition in this action and residents of Tulsa County for more than thirty (30) days immediately preceding the filing of the Petition.

2. That this is a Consent Decree such that the parties have negotiated and agreed to its terms and provisions as evidenced by their signatures hereon, waiving all objections and rights inconsistent with the terms hereof, and have asked this Court to make their agreement the order and judgment of this Court. The Court recognizes that this is a consent order, wherein each party, having adequate opportunity to discuss this matter and their rights with counsel of their choice, has knowingly, willingly, and intentionally waived such rights as they may have under the pleadings in this case, or under existing case or statutory law, specifically including the right to a hearing and trial on these issues, in order to resolve this matter in the manner hereinafter set forth. Further, to the extent that either party has waived any statutory rights to trial and hearing, etc., the Court finds that such waiver was knowingly entered into freely and voluntarily, and that each party agrees that the entry of this decree and accompanying orders are what the parties desire the Court order and decree.

3. That the parties were married on December 3, 2011, in Mont Belvieu, TX, and have been since that time, and are at the present time, husband and wife.

4. That of the marriage aforesaid no children have been born and the Respondent is not now pregnant.

5. That a state of irreconcilable incompatibility has arisen between the parties hereto which has completely destroyed the legitimate aims of the marriage and rendered cohabitation presently impossible; by reason of which, each party is entitled to decree of legal separation from the other.

6. That the parties stipulate and represent that they have fully disclosed to each other all marital and separate property held by each of them as well as all other matters relevant and material to a fair and equitable division of the marital estate between the parties.

7. That the parties have executed that certain Property Settlement Agreement effective June 1, 2015, in full settlement of their respective rights of support maintenance and the division of the marital estate and that the terms of such Agreement are fair and equitable and should be adopted as the Orders of the this Court by this reference; however, for privacy reasons, the same shall not be filed of record in the Court Clerk's office.

8. In carrying out the terms and provisions of such Property Settlement Agreement, each party is hereby ordered to execute, forthwith, all quit-claim deeds

or other instrument of conveyance as may be reasonably requested by the other party to effect the transfer and/or clear title of the business interests, real property interests and oil and gas interests awarded to the parties hereunder and pursuant to the Property Settlement Agreement.

9. That Petitioner shall pay shall pay all reasonable attorney's fees incurred by both parties accrued before the entry and filing date of the Decree.


10. That neither party has been a debtor in any bankruptcy proceeding during the pendency of this action, or in the six years preceding the filing of this action.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED by this Court that each party be, and they are hereby granted, a full, final and complete legal separation from each other, on the grounds of incompatibility.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED by this Court that the above and foregoing findings numbered one (1) through ten (10) inclusive are hereby **ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED** as if hereinafter set out at length, and judgment is rendered and entered accordingly.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED by the Court that each of the parties is hereby **ORDERED AND DIRECTED** to allow the other to take physical possession of the property awarded to him or her herein; and to execute and deliver to the other such assignments, bills of sale, deeds, or other

documents that may be reasonably necessary to carry out the terms of this order and judgment within twenty (20) days from the date this Decree is filed unless another time frame is specifically set out herein.

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


