


faith, of this state for the six (6) months immediately proceeding the filing of the petition. 43 O.S. Sec. 102.A. Contrary to Petitioner's allegation in his *Petition for Dissolution of Marriage*, Petitioner does not meet this requirement.

Petitioner filed his Petition on August 10, 2015; and, in order for Petitioner to have been a resident for six months before August 10, 2015, he would have had to have resided in the State of Oklahoma since February 10, 2015. The evidence will show, upon hearing this Motion, that Petitioner had been an actual resident of the State of Iowa during this six month period, and that Respondent (as well as the parties' minor children) is a resident of Iowa. Petitioner has resided with Respondent in Iowa during the six months immediately preceding the filing of Petitioner's Petition and, based upon the facts, the Court will be compelled to dismiss this matter.

WHEREFORE, Respondent prays that the Court dismiss this cause, order Petitioner to pay her attorney fees and costs of this Motion and grant her whatever other and further relief to which she is entitled by law and which the Court, in its sound discretion, deems to be fair and equitable.


