



1. That both parties hereto should and shall have equal rights and responsibilities to said minor children, and neither party's rights shall be superior.

2. That both parties hereto should and shall reasonably confer with one another by the most reasonable and appropriate method, and should and shall share decision-making authority as to important decisions affecting the physical, mental and moral welfare and upbringing of said minor children to arrive at decisions promoting said minor children's best interests.

3. That both parties hereto should and shall attempt to decide jointly the following matters, to-wit:

- A. medical, dental and health care said minor children should or shall receive;
- B. schools which said minor children should or shall attend;
- C. summer camps and church schools and/or classes which said minor children should or shall attend;
- D. fashion and manner in which said minor children should or shall be disciplined;
- E. extent of any travel of said minor children away from home, including purpose, duration, mode, chaperon, etc.;
- F. religious instruction said minor children should or shall receive; and
- G. such other areas requiring decisions affecting the growth and development of said minor children.

4. That in order to assure continuing association between the minor children and their parents, and to best promote and foster continued parent-children companionship, the physical custody shall be shared as follows

A. The parties will strive to achieve flexibility and respect for each other's schedules in terms of caring for the children. Further, the parties will have physical custody at a minimum during the following periods:

1. Regular Visitation: No later than December 15<sup>th</sup> of each year, Respondent shall provide a proposed schedule to Petitioner which would cover the entire subsequent year. Once a schedule is agreed upon by the parties, they shall each sign and date a copy of the schedule, with the visitation provisions contained therein being enforceable in the same manner as a court order. The parties are to work together to accommodate Respondent's fire department schedule, it being the intent of the parties that Respondent should receive between 130-140 overnights each year.

2. Holidays: Pursuant to the attached schedule;

3. Summer Break: Summer visitation will be week on/week off, with the parent who does not have physical custody having a "coke night" with the children once during the midweek. The parties should work together to ensure that vacation schedules and the like are accommodated;

4. Other: Variation or modification of any custodial periods described herein and/or such additional custodial periods as are agreed to in advance by the parties.

B. That both parties hereto shall be mindful and considerate of the children's school activities, sports activities, peer activities and associations, and the wishes of the children. In the event of a conflict respecting physical custody or visitation as hereinabove

provided, both parties hereto shall work together reasonably in advance to arrange for alternate periods of physical custody or visitation if necessary.

5. That in connection with said custody rights, if the parent exercising custody is going to be late or unable to exercise said custody, that parent shall notify the custodial parent within forty-eight (48) hours of said custody, except in case of emergency; FURTHER if either parent is unable to make the children available for good cause for custody, that custodial parent shall notify the other parent within forty-eight (48) hours of said custody.

6. That the term "school" means whatever school the children are attending.

7. The parties agree to share the cost of agreed upon extra-curricular activities equally. If a party is unable to pay his/her portion at the time the expense is incurred, the parent incurring the expense shall provide the other party a receipt within 45 days of incurring the expense and the other party shall reimburse that party within 45 days of receiving the receipt.

8. That both Petitioner and Respondent shall notify each other of any medical problem regarding the minor children requiring medical attention or of any illness that might occur while the child(ren) are in his/her physical custody.

9. That both parties hereto agree that during the period each of them has physical custody of the children, that parent should and shall decide all normal,

regular and routine matters concerning said children's welfare, and that each parent should and shall cooperate with one another in maintaining a mutually supportive arrangement regarding such normal, regular and routine matters.

10. Each party has the right of first refusal to personally provide care for the children at no cost in the event the other party must make child care arrangements for periods of time exceeding four (4) hours.

11. Each party shall immediately notify the other if one or both of their minor children are being kept out of school

12. Each party agrees to keep the other apprised of all individuals who may be providing child care for the minor children during his or her respective custodial periods.

13. That both parties hereto agree that the address and telephone number of one another, and those places where the minor children might be temporarily staying for more than a sleepover or visit with relatives, should and shall be known to each other at all times, and that each party-parent shall notify the other immediately of any illness, sickness or emergency that may arise while said minor children are in his or her physical custody.

14. That there shall be no overnight guests of the opposite sex until at least six (6) months after this Joint Custody Plan is entered, and the parties are in a serious and committed relationship. The parties agree not to introduce any dating

partner to the minor children unless it is a serious and committed relationship, and shall notify the other party in advance that he/she intends on introducing the children to his/her dating partner.

15. That both parties hereto agree that in the event either party remarries, that party's spouse should and shall be apprised of the terms of this Plan, and that party should and shall exert every reasonable effort to ensure that his or her spouse honors and respects the terms, provisions and conditions of said Plan.

16. That both parties agree that in the event of the death of either party, legal and physical custody of the minor children should and shall vest wholly and exclusively in the other party.

17. That both parties agree that approval of the other parent shall be required before travelling out of the country with the minor children, but that approval shall not be unreasonably withheld.

18. That both parties agree that they shall each abide by all safety laws in effect when transporting the children including use of seatbelts, car seats and/or booster seats and shall ensure that any third party he/she approves to transport the children also abides by all safety laws when transporting the children.

19. That any disagreement or dispute arising concerning the care, control, maintenance or management of the children shall be reasonably discussed by and between the parties, and if determined by the parties to be incapable of resolution,

the parties shall refer the issues to mediation prior to seeking Court intervention. If mediation is to be used and the parties cannot agree on the choice of mediator, they shall each submit the names of three (3) mediators to a hat and one (1) shall be chosen at random. The parties are to equally divide the expense of the mediator.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner, [REDACTED] and Respondent, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] jointly move the Court to approve the above and foregoing Joint Custody Plan as the Court's order in the best interests of the parties' minor children.

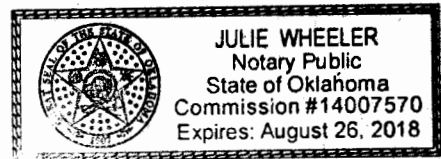
