

should be exercised.

4. Further, Title 43 O.S. §134(C) payment of Alimony as support may be modified upon proof of changed circumstances relating to the *need for support* or *ability to support*. This court, pursuant to *Epperson v. Epperson*, 1998 OK CIV APP 188, 972 P.2d 362, has the authority to modify payments due and owing prior to the filing of this motion to modify. *See Epperson*, supra, @ ¶10.
5. Since the entry of the *Decree of Dissolution of Marriage*, the factors upon which child support and alimony were computed have sufficiently changed so that under Oklahoma's Child Support Guidelines, 43 O.S. §118 and Title 43 O.S. §34(C), child support and alimony should be recomputed and modified in accordance with the law. More particularly, Respondent shows the Court that:
 - a. That Respondent was released from his employment with Schwan Food Company and has had to seek other employment which has lowered his income substantially since the entry of the Decree of Dissolution.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, Respondent prays that upon hearing this matter, the Court modify Respondent's child support obligations per the child support guidelines, issue an income assignment order against Respondent's employer, revise the alimony amount to be paid to Petitioner under the current orders, and grant such other and further relief which this Court deems just and proper.
