TEMPORARY ORDER

On this 28th day of June, 2017, this matter comes on before the Court for decision following the hearing on the parties' respective Motions for Temporary Order; Petitioner, ██████████ ("Father") represented by Ron W. Little of DOERNER SAUNDERS DANIEL & ANDERSON, LLP; Respondent ██████████ ("Mother"), represented by Shannon McMurray of THE FIRM ON BALTIMORE, PLLC, and the Court, having considered the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, enters the following findings and orders:

CHILD CUSTODY

1. THE COURT FINDS that it is in the best interests of the parties' minor children, ██████████ and ██████████, for joint legal custody to be awarded to the parties pursuant to 43 O.S. § 109 as set forth in the Joint Child Custody Plan attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SUPPORT

2. THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that, as support for Mother and the children, Father should pay Mother the sum of \$3,000.00 per month. Further, the Father should pay off the American Express credit card in Mother's name in an amount not to exceed approximately \$2,200.00. Further, Father should continue to pay those expenses of the parties and their children as he has historically paid in accordance with Petitioner's Exhibit No. 1 admitted at the

June 28, 2017 Temporary Order Hearing. The Court hereby reserves characterization of Father's payment of such funds and expenses (*i.e.*, child support or support alimony) for later determination by the Court.


3. THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that Mother should be awarded temporary and exclusive occupancy and use of the marital residence of the parties at 5819 E. 79th St., Tulsa, OK 74136 ("Marital Residence") along with all furnishings, furniture and personal property located therein except those items which Father may be provided by written agreement of the parties.

4. THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that Wife should be awarded temporary and exclusive use and possession of the 2012 Jaguar automobile in her possession. Further, that the Husband should be awarded temporary and exclusive use and possession of the 2004 Mercedes automobile in his possession.

MISCELLANEOUS


5. THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that each of the parties should be restrained from harassing the other or coming about the other's residence or any other non-public place the other party might be or from communicating with the other party, except as may be reasonably necessary to effect the previously scheduled and orderly exchange of physical custody of the parties' minor children, or by agreement of the parties, and to otherwise carry out the orders of this Court.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND DECREED that the above and foregoing findings are hereby adopted as the Orders of this Court as if hereinafter set forth at length and such Orders are hereby entered.



enroll the child in an extracurricular activity without the other's consent if the child is agreeable to such activity and at no time would the other parent's physical custody period be impacted by the child's participation.)

PHYSICAL CUSTODY

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall have actual physical custody rights of the children as follows:

- a. **Father:** Every Monday from 9:00 a.m. (or the time the children's school day begins when in session) until Wednesday at 6:00 p.m. (or the time the children's school day ends when in session).
- b. **Mother:** Every Wednesday at 6:00 p.m. (or the time the children's school day ends when in session) until Friday at 6:00 p.m.
- c. **Alternating Weekends:** Each parent shall be entitled to physical custody of the minor children on alternating weekends from Friday at 6:00 p.m. (or the time the children's school day ends when in session) to the following Monday at 9:00 a.m. (or the time the children's school day begins when in session) with Father's first such weekend to commence Friday, July 7, 2017.
- d. **Holiday Physical Custody:** Father shall be entitled to holiday physical custody of the children as follows. Mother shall be entitled to the same schedule of holiday physical custody in alternating years (*e.g.* if Father is entitled to physical custody of the children according to a specified schedule for any particular holiday in *even*-numbered years, Mother shall be entitled to physical custody of the children according to the same schedule in *odd*-numbered years and vice-versa).

1. **Labor Day:** In odd-numbered years, from 6:00 p.m. on the Friday

preceding Labor Day until 6:00 pm. on Labor Day.

2. Thanksgiving: In odd-numbered years, from 6:00 p.m. on the evening before Thanksgiving Day until 6:00 p.m. on the following Sunday.
 3. Christmas: In even-numbered years from 12:00 noon on December 24th until 12:00 noon on December 25th. In odd-numbered years, from 12:00 noon on December 25th until 12:00 noon on December 26th.
 4. Spring Break: In odd-numbered years, from 6:00 p.m. on the day school recesses, until 6:00 p.m. on the evening prior to resumption of classes.
 5. Easter: In even-numbered years, from 6:00 p.m. on the evening before Easter Sunday until 6:00 p.m. on Easter Sunday.
 6. Memorial Day: In odd-numbered years, from 6:00 p.m. on the Friday preceding Memorial Day until 6:00 p.m. on Memorial Day.
 7. Independence Day: In even-numbered years, from 6:00 p.m. on July 3rd until 6:00 p.m. on July 5th.
 8. Mother's Day: Mother has physical custody rights with the children each Mother's Day from 9:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.
 9. Father's Day: Father has physical custody rights with the children each Father's Day from 9:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.
- e. **Summer Break**: Each parent should have two weeks of physical custody with the minor children during the children's summer recess from school, uninterrupted by the other parent's exercise of physical custody, to be exercised

in two non-consecutive periods of one week each. Each parent shall notify the other of the weeks in which such physical custody rights shall be exercised by April 15th of each year. In the event of a conflict between the parents' respective choice of schedule, Father's choice shall control in odd-numbered years and Mother's choice shall control in even-numbered years.

- f. **Conflicts:** In the event of a conflict between one parent's Holiday Physical Custody rights and the other parent's Weekend, Weekly or Summer Break physical custody rights, the Holiday Physical Custody schedule and rights shall control.
- g. **Pick-Up and Delivery:** The parent whose actual physical custody rights are concluding shall deliver the children to school when in session. In the event the conclusion of the parent's physical custody period occurs on a day school is not in session, such parent shall deliver the child to the other parent's residence or, if requested by the other parent, the child's daycare provider.
- h. **Parenting Coordinator:** Jerry Perigo shall be appointed as the Parenting Coordinator for the parties for the pendency of this action.



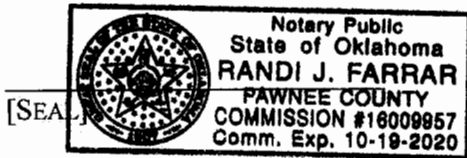


