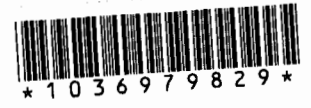

**MOTION TO ESTABLISH CHILD SUPPORT AND
DETERMINE CHILD SUPPORT ARREAGES**

COMES NOW the Respondent, [Redacted], by and through her attorney of record, David C. Fisher, and for her *Motion To Establish Child Support and Determine Child Support Arreages*, shows the Court as follows:

1. This *Motion* requests the establishment of a child support order and a determination of child support arreages more particularly described below concerning the parties' minor child.
2. Under all state and federal law, this Court has child support jurisdiction concerning the minor child. More particularly, under the Uniform Interstate Family Support Act, 43 O.S. §601-101 *et seq.*, and under the law of this state which grants this Court jurisdiction to establish child support orders, this Court has child support jurisdiction and the same should be exercised.
3. Since the entry of the *Temporary Order Agreement* on January 20, 2016, there has not been a determination of the amount of child support due from the Petitioner to the Respondent. The issue of child support was specifically reserved.

4. That Respondent has requested the Petitioner's income information so that child support may be calculated and to date, Petitioner has failed to produce the requested information.
5. That Petitioner has paid the Respondent a small amount for child support over the past year, and should be credited for those payments towards any arrearage that is determined.
6. Respondent is entitled to recover her reasonable attorney fees against.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, Respondent prays that upon hearing this matter, the Court establish Petitioner's monthly child support obligation per the Oklahoma Child Support Guidelines, issue an income assignment order against Petitioner's employer, determine arrearages for past due child support, grant judgment to Respondent for any child support arrearages; and grant such other and further relief which this Court deems just and proper.


