**PETITIONER'S MOTION TO COMPEL RESPONDENT'S DISCOVERY RESPONSES**

COMES NOW Petitioner [Redacted] pursuant to OKLA. STAT. tit. 12, §3237, and moves this Court to compel Respondent [Redacted] to fully respond *Petitioner's First Requests for Admission, Interrogatories, and Requests for Production of Documents to Respondent*. In support of this Motion, Petitioner alleges and states as follows:

1. On February 27, 2017, Petitioner's Counsel personally served the Respondent with *Petitioner's First Requests for Admission, Interrogatories, and Requests for Production of Documents to Respondent* (hereinafter, "Petitioner's discovery requests"). See Exhibit A and Exhibit B attached hereto.

2. On April 5, 2017, Petitioner's Counsel, in good faith, sent a letter to the opposing party regarding the past due discovery responses. See Exhibit C attached hereto.

3. On June 1, 2017, Petitioner's Counsel spoke with the Respondent, *pro se*, via telephone requesting that he respond to Petitioner's discovery requests. Respondent informed Petitioner's Counsel that he had lost the paperwork, and had requested that I mail to it his parents' address. Petitioner's Counsel mailed the Petitioner's discovery requests, again, on June 2, 2017.

4. To date, Respondent has failed to provide any responses to the requests for

admission, interrogatories and requests for production of documents.

5. The requested discovery is necessary for Petitioner to adequately prepare for settlement negotiations and trial on this matter.

6. Petitioner has in good faith conferred or attempted to confer either by letter or by telephone with the person or party failing to make the discovery in an effort to secure the information or material without court action.

7. Petitioner requests that this Court enter an Order compelling Respondent to fully respond to Petitioner's discovery requests by a date certain.

8. The filing of this Motion was caused by Respondent's failure to abide by the Discovery Code. As a result, Respondent should be ordered to pay Petitioner's attorney fees and costs associated with this Motion.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner requests the Court grant *Petitioner's Motion to Compel Respondent's Discovery Responses*, enter an order compelling Respondent to provide complete discovery responses by a date certain, grant Petitioner her attorney fees associated with this motion, and award such other and further relief as this Court deems equitable and just.

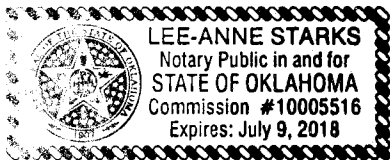

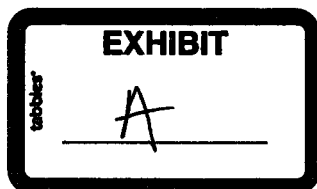

Under authority of Title 12, Oklahoma Statutes Annotated, Section 3233, you are hereby requested and required to make full, fair and complete answers in writing and under oath to the following questions, within thirty (30) days from receipt thereof:

**NOTE:** These Interrogatories are intended to ascertain information in your possession or that of your agents and employees, including attorneys or investigators, and that contained in records and documents in your or their custody or control, or available to you or them.

These Interrogatories shall be considered continuing and should answers to the same change before the trial of this action, you are requested to furnish such different answers, in writing and under oath, or it will be assumed that the answers originally given continue as your answers to said Interrogatories.

By the authority of the Oklahoma Discovery Code, 12 O.S. §§ 3201, *et seq.*, these Interrogatories, Requests for Admissions and/or Requests for Production of Documents are submitted for your prompt response. You must separately answer each numbered item, and your responses must be made under oath. These discovery requests are intended to define and simplify

the issues in controversy, and your answers must be sufficiently complete to avoid misleading by omission. Answers which embody ambiguities, negative pregnant, and the like, are not acceptable. You must also supplement your responses in a timely fashion if new or contradictory information becomes available to you after your initial written response.

For the Request for Admissions, please state whether you admit or deny each request. By Statute, if you fail to answer these Requests for Admissions within thirty (30) days, they are deemed admitted.

Upon request from counsel, we will provide these requests via e-mail so as to avoid the necessity of additional labor in re-typing these requests in your responses.

### Definitions

Unless otherwise noted, the words used in these interrogatories shall have their ordinary meaning at law. The following words shall be construed to have the meaning indicated, unless the context clearly requires otherwise:

- a. "Identify" shall mean:
  - 1. With regard to a document, the author, date of creation and respective revisions, the place where original is located, and the identity of all persons and offices known to have received photocopies.
  - 2. With regard to a photograph, the photographer, the date taken, all witnesses to the photograph being taken, and the location of the negative.
  - 3. With regard to an audio or video recording, the person making the recording, the date recorded, all witnesses to the recording, and the location of the original.
  - 4. With regard to a statement or conversation, the persons participating, the date, all witnesses to the conversation, and all documents and records reflecting the contents.
  - 5. With regard to real and personal property, a description of the item, and its present location.
  - 6. With regard to persons or witnesses, the name, home address and phone, and work address and phone.

- b. "Describe" shall mean:
1. The who, what, when, where, why, and how.
  2. As to a person, this shall include the name, home address and phone number, and work address and phone number of the person(s) involved, the location of the event, any person(s) present during the event.
  3. As to a location or event, this shall include identifying the location of the event, persons involved, description of the property, owner of the property, persons living at the property, dates, times, and full detail of the event.
  4. As to money or benefits, this shall include the amounts received, amounts paid, names of all recipients, dates received, and dates paid.
- c. "Contents" shall include when referring to a statement, the gist, summary, paraphrase or transcript of the statement.
- d. "You" and "Your" shall mean the Respondent, [REDACTED]

**ADMISSION NO. 4:** Admit that you have continually sent harassing text messages to the Petitioner.

**ADMISSION NO. 5:** Admit that you have denied the Petitioner the Right of First Refusal.

**ADMISSION NO. 6:** Admit that you cohabit with a significant other.

**ADMISSION NO. 7:** Admit that you failed to provide Petitioner with a physical address of where you resided during the months of mid-November 2015-mid-January 2016, and again from mid-May 2016 to mid-July 2016.

(In your answer please provide the name and address of the creditor, the account number, the date such indebtedness was incurred, the current unpaid balance, and the current minimum monthly payment.)

**INTERROGATORY NO. 7:** Regarding your current place of abode, describe said location in detail (e.g. house/duplex/apartment/etc.; number of bedrooms and bathrooms; square footage, etc.); identify all persons residing therein by name, age, and relationship to you; state the amount of money you pay toward the mortgage/rent; and identify the name and contact information of the owner of said residence, if applicable.

**REQUEST FOR PRODUCTION NO. 7:** Please produce complete copies of documentation and statements regarding all debts held in your name, including but not limited to, credit cards, loans, and mortgages held by you or in your name, showing the most recent balance due and payment terms.<sup>3</sup>

**REQUEST FOR PRODUCTION NO. 8:** Please produce copies of all personal diaries, journals, calendars or other notes or memoranda, audio or video tape or other digital means which are descriptive of any activity, speech, event or conduct of either you or of Respondent which was written during the past twelve (12) months.

Please note that if you are unable to obtain the document in a timely fashion, the party shall state in verified writing, under the penalty of perjury, the specific document which is not available, the reasons the document is not available, and what efforts have been made

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



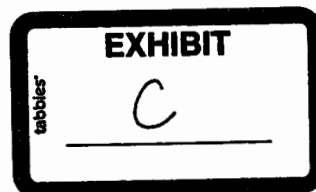
